Everyone received food when they needed it most, often during one of the worst times in their lives. Our focus for this year's appeal is "Nobody Forgotten This Christmas," as we want to ensure that everyone receives a Christmas dinner and food over the festive period. We want to let the people and the families that will be using our services know this Christmas that we, and people living in our communities throughout Stirling, care about them. Not just at Christmas, but throughout 2022.

We are very fortunate that we are being supported by Thistle Centre staff again this year and the Tolbooth.
