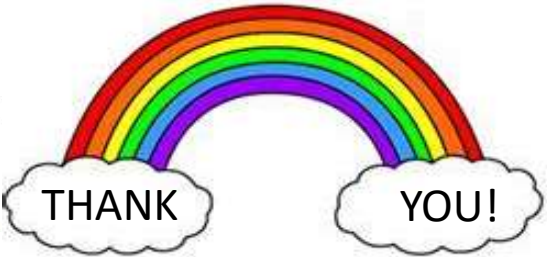
Start up Stirling volunteers are simply the best! We would like to say a massive thank you to you all for everything you do for the Charity - we couldn't run the Charity without you!
